BAPTISM NEXT SUNDAY

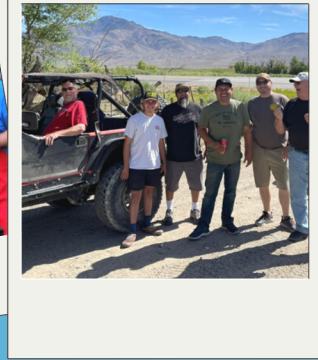
Next Sunday we will celebrate the sacrament of Baptism in place of Communion. Our next Communion service will be on June 4.
