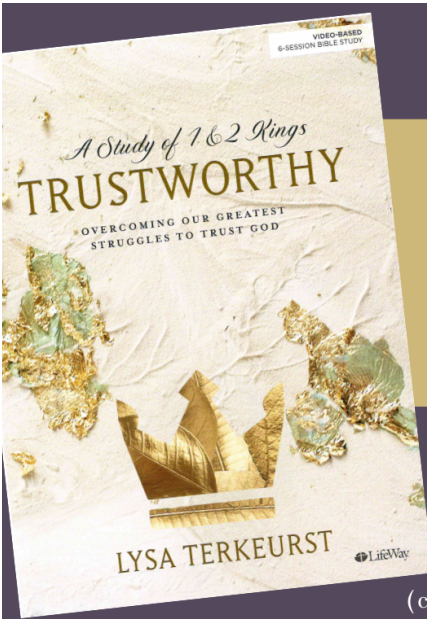
King's Kids Sundays

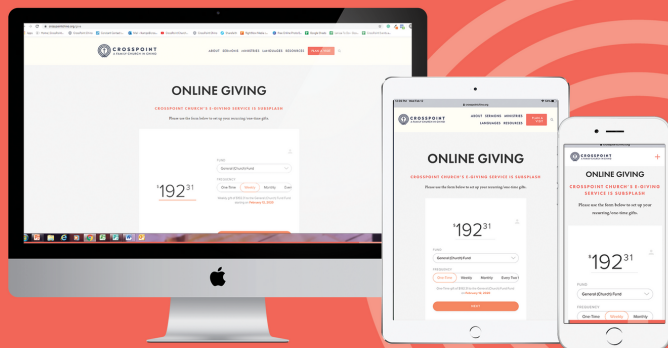
