## PRAYING FOR OUR PASTORS

October is Pastor Appreciation Month. CrossPoint will celebrate in the service later this month, but our pastors need our prayers daily!

Using Ephesians 6, here are some useful ways to pray for our pastors; covering them with prayer as the armor of God does and using one garment for each day of the week.\*

### The Helmet of Salvation

Ask God to guide their plans, vision, and sermon preparation and that they may know their sins are forgiven in Jesus. Pray that their minds may be continually renewed by a focus on God's gift of salvation and grace. Pray for discernment, wisdom, guidance and strength.

### The Belt of Truth

Ask God to keep your pastors constantly in God's Word, sensitive to His direction and will, and able to speak the truth boldly. Pray that their relationships with spouse, children, and friends may provide a strong witness.

### The Breastplate of Righteousness

Pray that your pastors may seek God with their whole heart. Pray that they will place Jesus on the throne of their life and that God will protect their heart with diligence. Ask God to bless them with physical, emotional, and financial well being.

### Feet Fitted With The Gospel

Ask God to help your pastors walk in ways that are obedient and pleasing to God, to keep their feet on solid ground, to keep them from straying, to lead them where God wants them to go, and to send them with eagerness into the world with the gospel.

### The Shield of Faith

Ask God to guard your pastors from discouragement, unreasonably negative people, and temptation. Ask God to protect their ministry, family, and personal walk with God. Pray that God will enable them to lead with integrity, live with confidence, and love with grace.

### Prayer

Ask God to give your pastors a passionate devotional life, to protect their quiet time with God, to clearly answer their prayers, and to bring fruit into their ministry.
