During Lent we will journey with Jesus to the cross, encountering Him through prayer, fasting, giving, and His Word. Like those in the gospels who sought Him, we seek transformation, healing, and restoration. Jesus changed the life of every person he met and encountering Him will change you too.

Today is the first Sunday of Lent, our 40-day journey with Jesus to the cross. Lent culminates with His crucifixion on Good Friday and His victorious resurrection on Easter Sunday. It has historically been a time for the Church to prepare for Christ's death and to reflect on His sacrifice on the cross for our salvation.

VISION

Investing in the next generation to be equipped for ministry

CrossPoint has been exploring if now is the time to carry on the vision for expanding our walls and ministry.

On Sunday, February 11, the 3 congregations voted on the motion to approve the sale of the 2.9 acre land parcel owned by CrossPoint and to use those sale proceeds for the construction of a new ministry building on campus. The motion was affirmed by 83% of CrossPoint voting members.

Thank you to all who have given to the campaign, voted, asked important questions, attended meetings, and prayerfully considered this next step.

The next phase includes preparations for marketing the land, while concurrently working on alternative ideas for funding. The campaign remains open to new pledges and insights regarding potential donors. If a better funding solution should emerge, it could potentially enable the retention of the land while still realizing the vision of a ministry building.
