QUESTIONS

- What was something in the passages or message that made an impact on you? Explain.

- Read John 13:31-35. In what ways is this a “new command?” Describe what you think it means when Jesus says, “As I have loved you, so you must love one another.” What characterizes the love of Jesus? How can you put this into practice this week?
- What is one practical way you can apply this sermon and Bible readings to your life?
