MISSION FOCUS SUNDAY

This month we focus on Abraham and Elaine Lee, who serve through Resonate Global Mission, the local and global mission arm of the Christian Reformed Church. They minister in Juarez, Mexico, just south of El Paso, Texas, by providing teaching, pastoral counseling, and coaching at All Nations Seminary (ANS). In the past 2 decades, ANS has graduated 500 students who are involved in many areas of ministry in Mexico including planting over 100 new churches. Elaine leads 6 different Coffee Break gatherings each week on zoom with women from 4 different time zones.

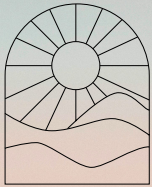
World Renew is the relief and development arm of the Christian Reformed Church that reaches out to people around the world who are struggling with poverty, hunger, disaster, and injustice.
